Dear Ms. Scott and Dr. Colosimo:

This letter is formal notification that Carrington College has decided to close the associate degree nursing program at our Las Vegas, Nevada campus. The program will be closed in March 2012, a time frame that will allow currently enrolled students to complete their degree program and sit for the national licensure exam.

Notwithstanding improvements in pass rates and facility improvements in recent months, the program continues to struggle with turnover and internal process issues, which are determining factors in our decision.

We will continue to teach the core nursing courses in semesters three through six until April 2012 when the last cohort graduates. Faculty will remain to provide remediation and assistance with NCLEX preparation following the last cohort graduation. Students in semester two will be provided a transcript and full refunds for the general education courses completed at Carrington. We will also provide these students assistance, if desired, with transferring to other area colleges, or another Carrington College program or campus.

Carrington College will continue to support faculty and students and ensure students receive quality education until the closure of the Las Vegas associate degree nursing program.
